Stay to the right at the next "Y"

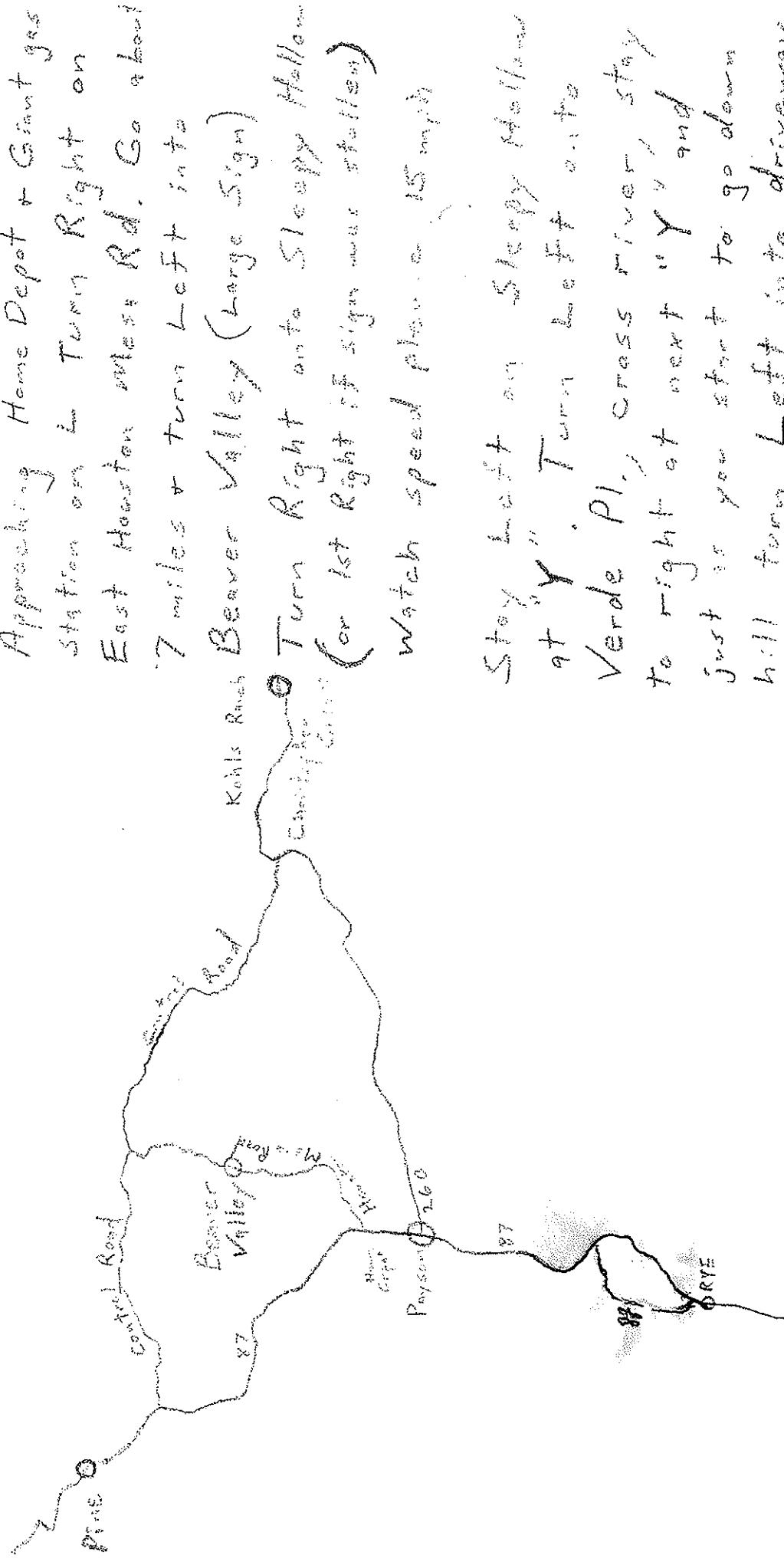

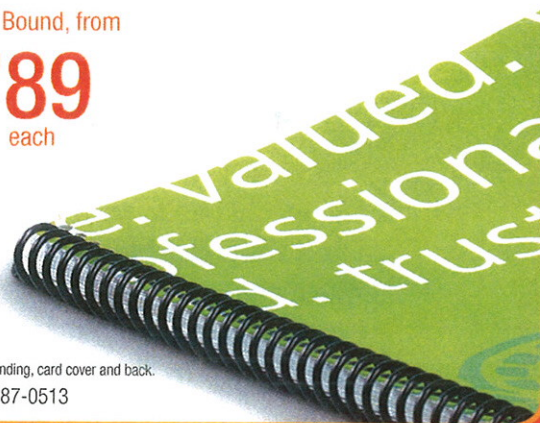
