Meeting was adjourned at 7:33 PM.

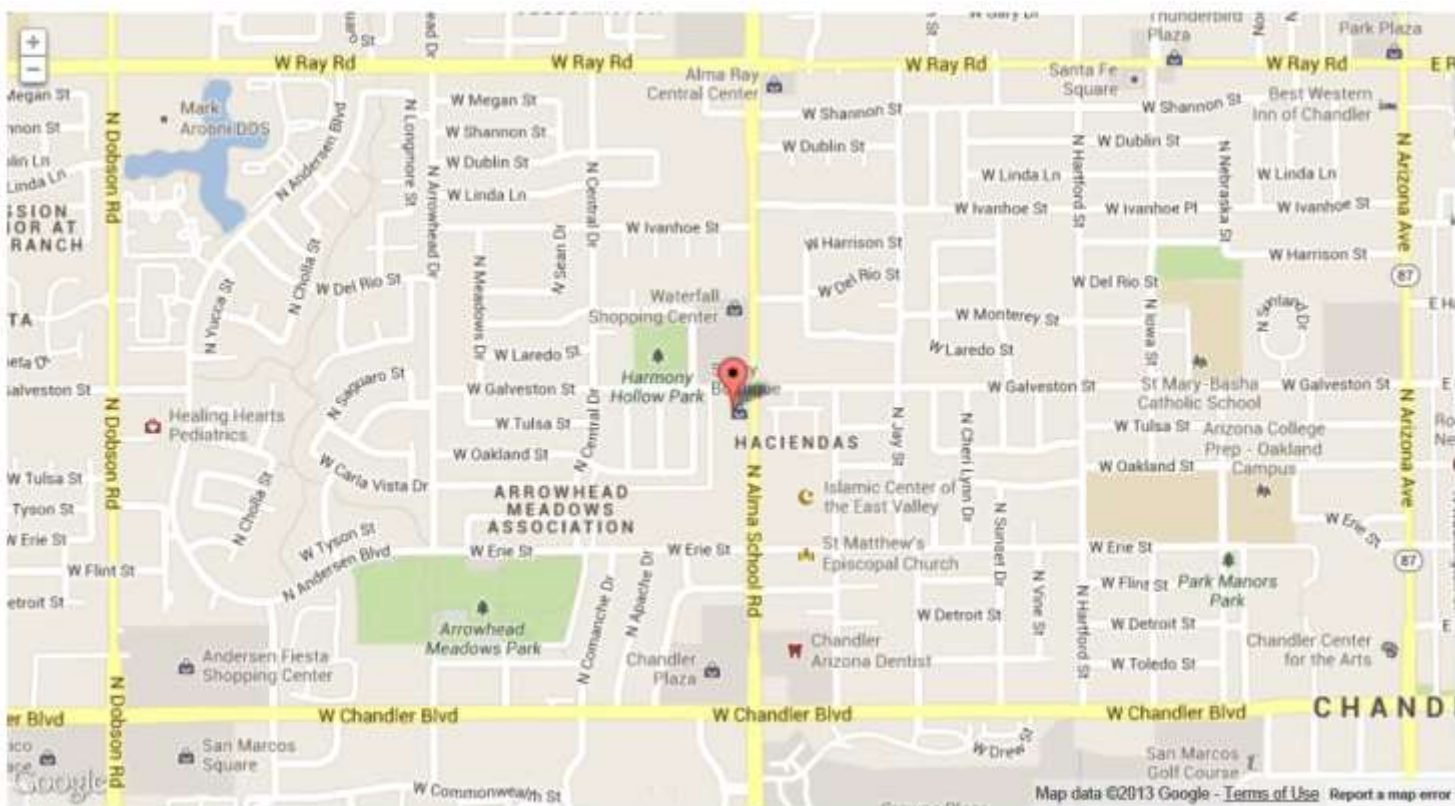
