TECH SESSION

Dave W. brought some copper/nickel brake line to show everyone. It is more flexible than steel and can be bent with your hands. Dave said to make sure you have a good tubing cutter and flaring tools. He then proceeded to show the group how to flare the end of brake line. He had a Cal-Van set off Amazon and it worked great.

Joe L. brought a Sport Wheel that he wanted to get painted with a wood-grain finish. He brought in the completed product with a beautiful Hydro-Graphic finish that he had done in Peoria. He will bring more information for us to the next meeting on where it was done. They dipped it into tub of water that has a printed image of wood floating on the surface. As the wheel is slowly dropped into the water, the graphic wraps around the wheel and is permanently adhered to it. Hydro-Graphics is a large scale, modern version of the old Easter egg coloring trick where some brightly colored oil-based paint drops float on top of the water surface as you slowly lower an egg into the water.

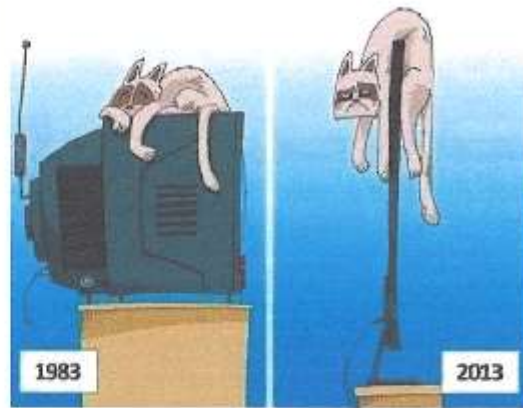
